

KINESIS LOW FORCE KEYPAD FOR MAC (AC210MUSB-wht)

Overview

Your new Kinesis Low-force USB keypad for Macintosh (AC210MUSB-wht) is optimized for Apple and OS X. It includes two USB ports to connect your keyboard and mouse (USB 1.1). The keypad uses generic HID drivers provided by the operating system, so no special drivers are required.

Features include premium low-force, tactile switches, long-lasting laser-inscribed legends, and three special keys at the top to boost productivity. Special hidden key actions are provided which are needed to install a numeric keypad on an Apple Macintosh computer.

Installation

The first time you connect this device, your computer should be fully booted up and logged in to your network if you have one. No drivers are necessary, but when you first plug in the keypad, you will get a screen asking to identify a new keyboard. (the keypad is treated like a keyboard by the operating system).

A U.S. keyboard is normally identified by pressing first the Z key (to the right of the left Shift), then the /? Key (to the left of the right Shift). Of course keypads do not have those keys, but you can find them on this keypad by holding the **fn** key. Pressing the “0” and “.” keys when the screen instructs you, respectively, to press the “key to the right of the left shift” and the “key to the left of the right shift.”

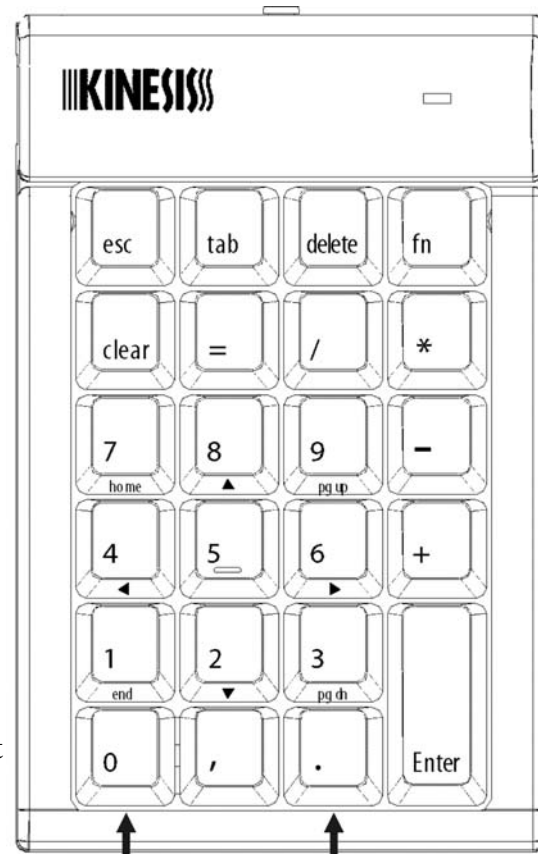
Front legends

To occasionally access the front-legend navigation keys, you must hold down the “fn” key. Do not overuse these actions as it can cause unnecessary strain to hold down the fn key while simultaneously reaching for another key. For frequent use, these same actions should be available on your keyboard.
